

## **Tentative timeline**

### **Cabarrus/Stanly County Line Resurvey Process**

*\*This timeline is a general guide based on previous resurvey processes.  
All upcoming dates are tentative and subject to change/revision.\**

#### **February 4, 2013**

##### **Cabarrus County Board of Commissioners Work Session**

Cabarrus County Tax Administration staff presented on the scope of the project and made a request for the Board's guidance. The Board gave permission for staff to move forward and inform the public of the potential resurvey.

#### **March 7, 2013**

##### **Cabarrus County Public Meeting for Property Owners**

*Mt. Pleasant Public Library (8556 Cook Street, Mt. Pleasant) 4-7 p.m.*

An informal meeting and discussion to address property owners' questions and/or concerns.

#### **April 15, 2013**

##### **Cabarrus County Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting**

*Cabarrus County Governmental Center (65 Church Street SE, Concord) 6:30 p.m.*

Cabarrus County Tax Administration staff will request Cabarrus County Board of Commissioners' approval to authorize NCGS (Stewart Engineering) to resurvey county line. Citizens will have the opportunity to make public comments on the issue.

#### **April/May 2013**

Pending approval by both the Cabarrus and Stanly Boards of Commissioners, local legislation will be introduced to the N.C. Legislature that would ratify the Cabarrus/Stanly county line resurvey.

#### **June 2013**

Pending approval by the N.C. Legislature, NCGS will complete the physical survey and place monuments at key points. These monuments will aid private surveyors in completing accurate maps.

#### **July 2013**

County staff will present survey map(s) to the Cabarrus and Stanly Boards of Commissioners and seek adoption of the resurveyed line as the official boundary line between the counties. Citizens will have the opportunity to make public comments on the issue.

#### **October 2013**

The Register of Deeds offices in Cabarrus and Stanly counties will record the adopted maps.

#### **November/December 2014**

Cabarrus County Tax Administration and Land Records offices will notify/inform Cabarrus County property owners of the amount of land units that each county will assess.

#### **January 1, 2015**

The effective date of land unit updates for assessment.

#### **August 2015**

Real Property Tax Bill amounts reflect all adjusted acreages. Process complete.
